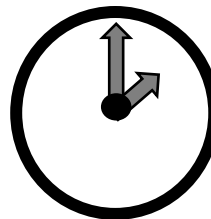

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1:

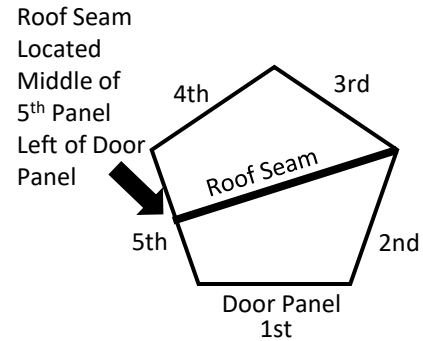
Prepare blind (Sold Separately) for cover installation by closing door and all windows on blind.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Booner 5 Panel HW Dagger Blind – Make sure roof seam is located so roof seam starts from middle of 5th panel left of door panel and extends to other side of blind between 2nd and 3rd panels on right side of door. Cover is designed to fit seam in this location. If roof seam is not in this location, disassemble roof and reconfigure so roof seam is in this location.

Step 2:

Locate NEXCAM Cover and unfold cover so camo fabric is on outside. Unzip two sides of the cover by unzipping zipper up to roof.

Step 3:

Position NEXCAM Cover so door side of cover lines up with door. With 1 or 2 people pull blind cover overtop of blind and position so door and windows on cover line up with door and windows on blind.

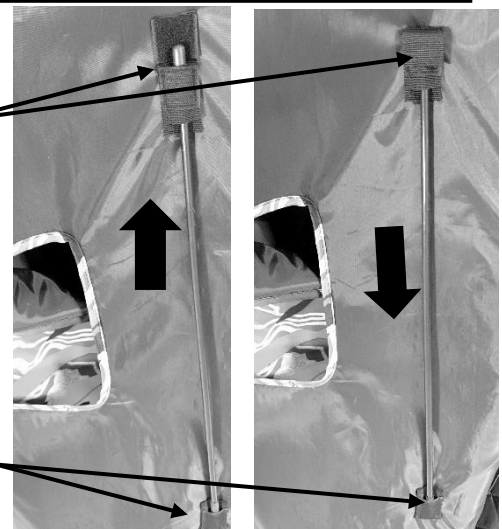
Step 4:

Go inside blind and open windows. On inside of NEXCAM Cover (in between cover and blind) install fiber curtain rod in sleeve by sliding rod through upper sleeve (Velcro side) and insert other end into lower webbing sleeve. Repeat for other side of window.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 5:

Install Mesh Curtains by sliding rods up through upper sleeve (with Velcro) so other end of rod is out of lower sleeve. Slide mesh curtain bungee loops onto lower end of rod. Slide rod down into lower sleeve and place Velcro down on upper sleeve to securely lock fiber curtain rod in place. Repeat for other curtain rod. Stretch curtain overtop of window opening by sliding curtain on fiber curtain rods.

Repeat Steps 4 and 5 for remaining windows.

Note – Make sure loops are in line so curtain is flat when extended over window opening.

Step 6:

Attach Door onto blind door by removing Velcro corner flaps on cover. Place corner flaps overtop blind door corners, line up door handles with cover openings and secure with Velcro.

Step 7:

Attach bungee loops and hooks to blind door sides and/or to blind door frame (if applicable). These are used to keep Cover tight to the door.

Step 8:

Zip front and back zippers of cover from roof down to bottom of blind. This will tighten entire cover up around blind.

Secure NEXCAM Cover to blind by inserting ground stakes through grommets on cover and anchoring to ground or by bolting / screwing cover grommets to blind platform.

NEXCAM Cover is installed and ready for use.

Enter blind with NEXCAM Cover installed by opening door. To open and adjust mesh curtain position, open blind window and slide curtain to desired position.

STORAGE:

Even though NEXCAM Cover is designed for years of outdoor use, it is recommended to remove NEXCAM Cover after hunting season is complete or if NEXCAM Cover will not be used for several months. Store indoors in a clean dry location out of direct sunlight. This will increase the life of the product and protect it from damage due to extreme weather conditions, animals, insects, etc.
